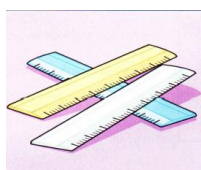

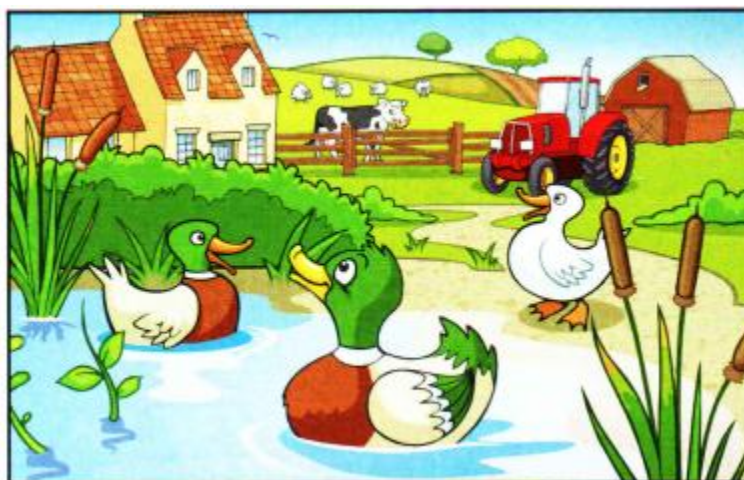

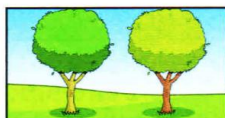


There are lots of animals on Mary's farm. There are some chickens, ducks and a

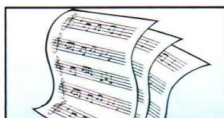

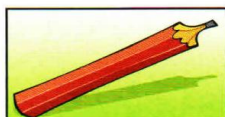
