Simple Present and Present Progressive

2. Present Progressive tense :

_ Use the present progressive for things you are doing at the time of speaking.

_ Time expressions : now , right now , today , at the moment , at present

_ Formation : S + **am , is , are** + V-**ing**

Ex : They are wearing blue uniforms today.

_ How to make “ **ing** ” form :

- most Verbs + **ing**

work → working ; eat → eating ; drink → drinking...

- verbs ending in “ **-e** ” : “~~e~~” + ing

write → writing ; hope → hoping

- verbs ending in “ **-ie** ” : → “ **y** ” + ing

lie → lying

- doubling :

stop → **stopping** ; run → **running** ; begin → **beginning**

_ Three forms : positive , negative and questions

- Positive form : S + am , is , are + V-ing

Ex : She is reading newspaper now.

- Negative form : S + am , is , are + not + V-ing

Ex : We are not studying P.E at present.

- Yes _ No question : Am , Is , Are + S + V-ing?

Ex : Are you playing tennis right now ?
