old ⇒ oldest young ⇒ youngest fast ⇒ fastest slow ⇒ slowest	happy ⇒ happiest busy ⇒ busiest funny ⇒ funniest pretty ⇒ prettiest	big ⇒ biggest thin ⇒ thinnest fat ⇒ fattest hot ⇒ hottest
